Attendance

Regular punctual attendance builds success. Students thrive with consistent and predictable routines. We will work to minimize disruption in routines and we ask that families partner with us to establish these routines early. Our day begins at 8:35 AM and it's essential that students be in class to receive their start of day instructions. If your child(ren) will be absent please call safe arrival 1 844 350 2646. It is also important that your child stay in school until 3:10 dismissal time. There is still valuable learning occurring during the end of the day.

Dismissal at the End of the Day

Please ensure you have communicated with your child(ren)'s teacher(s) how your child is to be dismissed at the end of the day (e.g. kiss n ride, bus, parent or sibling pick up, etc...). This needs to be pre-planned with your child as well. If you are picking up multiple students or grade 4-8 students, plan a meeting place where you can connect each day. If there is going to be a change to the usual pick up plan, please send a note to the teacher in advance. Last minute changes are difficult to effectively communicate to all stakeholders. Finally, please ensure your child knows to go to the office if they are unsure of the pick up plan, or the plan hasn't worked out as expected.
